6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public works; amending 61 O.S.
8 2021, Section 103.8 which relates to locations of
9 company headquarters; requiring state agencies that
10 award certain contracts to provide certain
11 information; requiring agency directors to provide
12 certain explanations under certain circumstances; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 61 O.S. 2021, Section 103.8, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 103.8. A. When a state agency accepts a services type
18 of contract, whether bid or no-bid, it shall list the city, state,
19 and country in which the services will be prepared and produced.
20 Any work the state awards that is not strictly awarded by the lowest
21 price and that is awarded to a company not preparing and producing
22 the services in Oklahoma, shall require the awarding agency's
23 director to provide reasons why the services are not prepared and
24 produced in Oklahoma.

1 B. When a state agency accepts any other type of contract,
2 whether bid or no-bid, it shall list the city, state, and country in
3 which the company that is seeking or awarded work is headquartered.
4 If the company is an Oklahoma entity of which over fifty percent
5 (50%) is owned by an out-of-state entity or individual, then, for
6 the purposes of this section, the location of the company's
7 headquarters shall be considered to be in the city, state and
8 country of the majority owner. Any work the state awards that is
9 not strictly awarded by the lowest price and that is awarded to a
10 company not headquartered in Oklahoma shall require the awarding
11 agency's director to provide reasons why the out-of-state company
12 was chosen over an Oklahoma company.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
