6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge
8 designations; designating the Trooper J.C. Magar
9 Memorial Highway; designating the Edward A. DeVore,
10 Jr., Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient, Memorial
11 Bridge; designating the CPL Russell Keck, Navy Cross
12 Recipient, Memorial Highway; requiring certain
13 markers; providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The portion of State Highway 271 beginning south of the
20 municipal limits of Hugo and ending north of the municipal limits of
21 Grant shall be designated as the "Trooper J.C. Magar Memorial
22 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
23 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

24 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over Coal Creek located on US Route 75 Business
2 within the municipal limits of Henryetta shall be designated as the
3 "Edward A. DeVore, Jr., Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient,
4 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
5 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
6 bridge.

7 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The portion of State Highway 56 beginning just west of North
11 Wood Drive and extending approximately one (1) mile west through the
12 municipal limits of Okmulgee shall be designated as the "CPL Russell
13 Keck, Navy Cross Recipient, Memorial Highway". The Department of
14 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
15 name to be placed on the highway.

16 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
