5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the practice of pharmacy;
7 prohibiting pharmacist from making certain inquiries;
8 providing penalties; providing for codification; and
9 providing an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 353.20.3 of Title 59, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 If a pharmacist receives a valid prescription for chloroquine,
15 hydroxychloroquine, or ivermectin, the pharmacist shall not inquire
16 about the intended use of the drug by the patient or the condition
17 for which the drug is prescribed. If the State Board of Pharmacy
18 finds that a pharmacist is in violation of this section, the Board
19 shall immediately revoke the license of the pharmacist and fine the
20 pharmacist One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) per
21 occurrence.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
