12 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and
13 entire bill and insert

14 "An Act relating to Route 66; amending Section 1,
15 Chapter 412, O.S.L. 2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section
16 4040), which relates to the Oklahoma Route 66
17 Commission; removing sunset date; modifying
18 appointment; updating statutory references; and
19 declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 412, O.S.L.
22 2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 4040), is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 Section 4040. A. There is hereby created ~~until June 30, 2027,~~
the Oklahoma Route 66 Commission. The Commission shall be composed
of nine (9) members. The members shall serve as follows:

1 1. One member shall be appointed by the Governor and selected
2 from the Commissioners of the Oklahoma Tax Commission, whose first
3 term shall be for one (1) year, and then renewable for three-year
4 terms thereafter;

5 2. One shall be the Executive Director of the ~~Oklahoma~~
6 Department of Transportation, or his or her designee, whose first
7 term shall be for two (2) years, and then renewable for three-year
8 terms thereafter;

9 3. One shall be the ~~Executive Director of the Oklahoma Tourism~~
10 ~~and Recreation Department~~ Secretary of Tourism and Branding, or his
11 or her designee, whose first term shall be for three (3) years, and
12 then renewable for three-year terms thereafter;

13 4. Three members shall be appointed by the President Pro
14 Tempore of the ~~Oklahoma State~~ Senate of which:

15 a. one shall be a citizen of a county containing a
16 portion of Route 66, whose first term shall be for one
17 (1) year, and renewable for three-year terms
18 thereafter,

19 b. one shall be a city manager, assistant city manager,
20 or economic development director for a municipality on
21 Route 66 with a population greater than ten thousand
22 (10,000), whose first term shall be for two (2) years,
23 and renewable for three-year terms thereafter, and
24

1 c. one shall be an Oklahoma citizen with expertise or
2 experience in historic preservation, whose first term
3 shall be for three (3) years, and then renewable for
4 three-year terms thereafter; and

5 5. Three members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the
6 Oklahoma House of Representatives of which:

7 a. one shall be a citizen of a county containing a
8 portion of Route 66, whose first term shall be for one
9 (1) year, and then renewable for three-year terms
10 thereafter,

11 b. one of whom shall be a business owner whose business
12 is located along Route 66 within a city or town whose
13 population is less than ten thousand (10,000), whose
14 first term shall be for two (2) years, and then
15 renewable for three-year terms thereafter, and

16 c. one shall be an Oklahoma citizen with expertise or
17 experience in marketing, whose first term shall be for
18 three (3) years, and then renewable for three-year
19 terms thereafter.

20 B. The Commission shall utilize the Oklahoma Route 66
21 Commission Revolving Fund as authorized in Section ~~2 of this act~~
22 4041 of this title.

23 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.”
