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An Act relating to the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1703, which relates to
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length; modifying actions regarding removal of appointive members; requiring full membership to
perform duties; prohibiting members from participating in certain votes; and providing an
effective date.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1703, is
amended to read as follows:
Section 1703. A. There is hereby created a body corporate and
politic to be known as the "Oklahoma Turnpike Authority" and by that
name the Authority may sue and be sued, and plead and be impleaded.
The Authority is hereby constituted an instrumentality of the state,
and the exercise by the Authority of the powers conferred by this
act in the construction, operation, and maintenance of turnpike
projects shall be deemed and held to be an essential governmental
function of the state with all the attributes thereof. Provided,

however, the Turnpike Authority is authorized to carry and shall carry liability insurance to the same extent and in the same manner as the Transportation Commission, and in addition thereto it shall be subject to the workers' compensation laws of the state the same as a private construction project.

6 The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall consist of the Β. 7 Governor, who shall be a member ex officio, and six (6) members to be appointed by the Governor, by and with the consent of the two (2) 8 9 members to be appointed by the Governor, two (2) members to be 10 appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, 11 and two (2) members to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of 12 the Oklahoma State Senate. The appointive members shall be 13 residents of the state, and shall have been qualified electors 14 therein for a period of at least one (1) year next preceding their 15 appointment. One appointive member shall be appointed from each of six districts of the state, such districts to include the area as 16 17 follows:

18 District 1. Oklahoma, Canadian, Cleveland, McClain and Garvin 19 Counties.

District 2. Washington, Nowata, Craig, Ottawa, Rogers, Mayes,
Delaware, Wagoner, Cherokee, Adair, Okmulgee, Osage, Muskogee,
Sequoyah, McIntosh and Haskell Counties.

District 3. Coal, Logan, Payne, Lincoln, Creek, Okfuskee,
Pottawatomie, Seminole, Hughes and Pontotoc Counties.

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District 4. Kay, Pawnee, Garfield, Noble, Tulsa, Woods,
 Woodward, Major, Alfalfa and Grant Counties.

District 5. Cimarron, Grady, Texas, Beaver, Harper, Ellis,
Roger Mills, Dewey, Custer, Caddo, Washita, Beckham, Harmon,
Stephens, Jefferson, Greer, Kiowa, Jackson, Tillman, Comanche,
Cotton, Kingfisher and Blaine Counties.

District 6. Carter, Love, Murray, Johnston, Marshall, Atoka,
Bryan, Pittsburg, Latimer, Le Flore, Pushmataha, Choctaw and
McCurtain Counties.

10 The members of the Authority appointed shall continue in office 11 for terms expiring as follows: District 1, July 1, 1968; District 12 2, July 1, 1971; District 3, July 1, 1972; District 4, July 1, 1973; 13 District 5, July 1, 1974; District 6, July 1, 1975. Provided, that 14 appointive The Governor shall appoint the members from Districts 1 15 and 2. The Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives shall 16 appoint the members from Districts 3 and 4. The President Pro 17 Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate shall appoint the members from 18 Districts 5 and 6. Appointive members serving on the Oklahoma 19 Turnpike Authority created by 69 O.S. 1961, Section 653, when this 20 act becomes on the effective date of this act shall continue to 21 serve as members of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority created by this 22 section, for the remainder of the original terms for which they were 23 appointed, unless sooner removed by the Governor appointing 24 authority for their District. The successor of Thereafter, each

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1 appointive member shall be appointed in the manner set forth by this Section for a term of eight (8) six (6) years, except that any 2 person appointed to fill a vacancy shall be appointed to serve only 3 4 for the unexpired term, and a member of the Authority shall be 5 eligible for reappointment. Each appointed member of the Authority before entering upon the duties of office shall take an oath as 6 7 provided by Section 1 of Article XV of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma. Any appointive member of the Authority may be removed 8 9 by the Governor at any time with or without cause by the appointing 10 authority.

11 C. The Authority shall elect one of the appointed members as 12 chairperson and another as vice-chairperson, and shall also elect a 13 Secretary and Treasurer. A majority of the members of the Authority 14 shall constitute a quorum and the vote of a majority of the members 15 shall be necessary for any action taken by the Authority. No A 16 vacancy in the membership of the Authority shall impair the right of 17 a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all the duties of 18 the Authority.

19 <u>D. Appointed members of the Authority shall be prohibited from</u> 20 <u>voting on any issue in which the member has a direct financial</u> 21 interest.

22 D. E. Before the issuance of any turnpike revenue bonds under
23 the provisions of this act, each appointed member of the Authority
24 shall execute a surety bond in the penal sum of Twenty-five Thousand

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Dollars (\$25,000.00) and the secretary and treasurer shall execute a surety bond in the penal sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), each such surety bond to be conditioned upon the faithful performance of the duties of the office, to be executed by a surety company authorized to transact business in the State of Oklahoma as surety and to be approved by the Governor and filed in the office of the Secretary of State.

E. F. The members of the Authority shall not be entitled to 8 9 compensation for their services, but each member shall be reimbursed 10 for actual expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of the 11 duties of such member. All expenses incurred in carrying out the 12 provisions of this act shall be payable solely from funds provided 13 under the authority of this act and no liability or obligation shall 14 be incurred by the Authority hereunder beyond the extent to which 15 monies shall have been provided under the authority of this act.

16 F. G. Whenever the terms "Oklahoma Transportation Authority", 17 "Transportation Authority" or "Authority", when used in reference to 18 the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, appear in the Oklahoma Statutes, 19 such terms shall mean the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
