10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3001 of Title 25, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The use of internal combustion engines including, but not  
15 limited to, technology, equipment, mechanical systems, or  
16 transportation and gas-fueled stoves, shall not be prohibited by  
17 this state or any political subdivision of this state. The rights  
18 of individuals in Oklahoma to use internal combustion engines and  
19 gas-fueled stoves shall be protected in this state.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
