11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-730.1 of Title 63, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The laws of this state pertaining to abortion shall not be
16 construed to in any way prohibit, restrict, limit, or otherwise
17 affect the provision of contraceptive drugs, surgeries, or other
18 treatments by a duly authorized healthcare provider in accordance
19 with the laws of this state.

20 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
