17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 187A-6 of Title 73, unless there
20	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the
22	Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority is authorized to utilize
23	available funds from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund created by
24	Enrolled House Bill No. 1002 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the

1 59th Oklahoma Legislature, in the amount of Seventeen Million Six 2 Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$17,605,000.00) to be distributed to 3 the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for the benefit of 4 the Oklahoma Department of Libraries, to construct, refurbish, or 5 expand the facilities utilized by the Department of Libraries.

B. LCF Recapitalization Payments shall be made related to the
distribution of proceeds provided in subsection A of this section,
in accordance with the provisions of the Legacy Capital Financing
Act.

C. The Authority may distribute funds authorized pursuant to
 subsection A of this section in one or more tranches.

D. The Authority may enter memoranda of understanding with agencies, departments, and subdivisions of the state as needed, to facilitate the provisions of this act, provided that such memoranda of understanding do not constitute a legal obligation of the State of Oklahoma or impede the administration of the provisions of the Legacy Capital Financing Act.
