11 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Legacy Capital Financing Fund;
13 authorizing utilization of portion of certain amount
14 for certain purpose benefiting the Council on Law
15 Enforcement Education and Training; requiring certain
16 recapitalization payments; authorizing certain
17 distributions; authorizing and limiting utilization
18 of memoranda of understanding; and providing for
19 codification.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 187A-1 of Title 73, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the
Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority is authorized to utilize

1 available funds from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund created by
2 Enrolled House Bill No. 1002 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the
3 59th Oklahoma Legislature, in the amount of Three Million Nine
4 Hundred Eighty-three Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Dollars
5 (\$3,983,620.00) for the benefit of the Council on Law Enforcement
6 Education and Training to facilitate the construction of new or
7 expanding training facilities.

8 B. LCF Recapitalization Payments shall be made related to the
9 distribution of proceeds provided in subsection A of this act, in
10 accordance with the provisions of the Legacy Capital Financing Act.

11 C. The Authority may distribute funds authorized pursuant to
12 subsection A in one or more tranches.

13 D. The Authority may enter memoranda of understanding with
14 agencies, departments, and subdivisions of the state as needed, to
15 facilitate the provisions of this act, provided that such memoranda
16 of understanding do not constitute a legal obligation of the State
17 of Oklahoma or impede the administration of the provisions of the
18 Legacy Capital Financing Act.
