8 An Act relating to child care; mandating payment of
9 child care provider contract on weekly basis;
10 requiring child care reimbursement to be based on
11 enrollment and daily attendance; providing for rate
12 determination based on tier level; providing for
13 potential loss of benefit for certain absences;
14 requiring Department of Human Services to conduct
15 annual market rate survey; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230.74 of Title 56, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. A child care facility licensed by the Department of Human
22 Services with a current child care provider contract shall receive
23 reimbursement at the beginning of each week, fifty percent (50%)
24 which shall be based on enrollment and fifty percent (50%) which
shall be based on actual daily attendance. The rate shall be
determined by the tier level of the child care facility where the

1 child is enrolled and the age of each child on the contract for the
2 child care subsidy program minus the family copayment.

3 B. The Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card of the child
4 shall only be swiped in on days in attendance and shall not be
5 required to be swiped out. In the event that a child misses ten
6 (10) consecutive days of attendance without prior approval from the
7 child care facility and a caseworker from the Department, the child
8 may lose approval for the child care subsidy program and may be
9 required to reapply in the program.

10 C. The Department shall conduct an annual market rate survey to
11 ensure compliance with the seventy-fifth-percentile payment rate as
12 required by the federal Child Care and Development Block Grant.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
