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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230.74 of Title 56, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. A child care facility licensed by the Department of Human
20	Services with a current child care provider contract shall receive
21	reimbursement at the beginning of each week, fifty percent (50%)
22	which shall be based on enrollment and fifty percent (50%) which
23	shall be based on actual daily attendance. The rate shall be
24	determined by the tier level of the child care facility where the

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child is enrolled and the age of each child on the contract for the
child care subsidy program minus the family copayment.

B. The Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card of the child shall only be swiped in on days in attendance and shall not be required to be swiped out. In the event that a child misses ten (10) consecutive days of attendance without prior approval from the child care facility and a caseworker from the Department, the child may lose approval for the child care subsidy program and may be required to reapply in the program.

10 C. The Department shall conduct an annual market rate survey to 11 ensure compliance with the seventy-fifth-percentile payment rate as 12 required by the federal Child Care and Development Block Grant. 13 SECTION 2.
