8 An Act relating to public school transportation;
9 requiring the State Department of Education make
10 certain annual reimbursement to public school
11 districts; requiring submission of certain records
12 and receipts; providing for means of making certain
13 expenditures; authorizing the promulgation of certain
14 rules and procedures; creating the Public School
15 District Turnpike Reimbursement Fund; stating the
16 type of fund; providing for funding; stating purpose
17 of the fund; providing for expenditures from fund;
18 providing for codification; and providing an
19 effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9-120 of Title 70, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 The State Department of Education shall annually reimburse
public school districts for charges incurred by the public school
districts' operation of public school transportation equipment and
auxiliary transportation equipment, as defined by Section 9-104 of

1 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, on Oklahoma Turnpike Authority
2 tollways. Public school districts wishing to receive reimbursement
3 shall annually submit to the Department official records and
4 receipts depicting charges incurred on tollways. The Department
5 shall make expenditures for reimbursement from the Public School
6 District Turnpike Reimbursement Fund created in section 2 of this
7 act. The Department is authorized to promulgate rules and any
8 necessary procedures to effectuate the provisions of this section.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9-121 of Title 70, unless there
11 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund for the
13 State Department of Education to be designated the "Public School
14 District Turnpike Reimbursement Fund". The fund shall be a
15 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
16 consist of any monies the Legislature may appropriate or transfer to
17 the fund and any monies contributed to the fund from any other
18 source, public or private. All monies accruing to the credit of the
19 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
20 State Department of Education for the purpose of annual
21 reimbursement payments to public school districts for eligible toll
22 road expenditures pursuant to Section 1 of this act. Expenditures
23 from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
24 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the

1 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
2 approval and payment.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
