PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to consumer credit; prohibiting
release of certain information related to credit to
third parties without consent; providing for
codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-412 of Title 14A, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If a person requests a report from a consumer reporting agency
in connection with a credit transaction involving any extension of
credit, such agency may not, solely on the basis of such request,
furnish a report to a third party unless such third party has the
consumer's consent or has a current relationship, relating to
credit, servicing, or other financial services, with such consumer.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
