8 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending  
9 63 O.S. 2021, Section 5060, which relates to state  
10 Medicaid program not to contract with out of state  
11 providers; unauthorizing the Oklahoma Health Care  
12 Authority from providing coverage for certain out of  
13 state Medicaid programs in certain situations; and  
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 5060, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 5060. A. Where practicable and in accordance with  
19 state and federal law, the state Medicaid program shall not contract  
20 with an out-of-state medical provider for treatment that is  
21 available from one or more providers licensed and practicing in the  
22 State of Oklahoma.

23 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall not authorize  
24 payment through the state Medicaid program to an out-of-state  
medical provider unless that state also allows their residents to

1 contract with providers under their state Medicaid program in  
2 Oklahoma.

3 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall seek any federal  
4 approval necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
