9 An Act relating to agriculture; creating the  
10 International Livestock Judging Competition Grant  
11 Act; creating the International Livestock Judging  
12 Competition Revolving Fund; directing the Department  
13 of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to administer the  
14 act; directing the State Board of Agriculture to  
15 promulgate rules and adopt certain guidelines;  
16 providing for grants; identifying eligible grant  
17 recipients; providing for grant limitations;  
18 providing for codification; and providing an  
19 effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-1 of Title 2, unless there is  
23 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "International  
Livestock Judging Competition Grant Act".

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-2 of Title 2, unless there is  
3 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
5 fund for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry  
6 to be designated the "International Livestock Judging Competition  
7 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject  
8 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received  
9 by the State Board of Agriculture from state-appropriated funds,  
10 federal funds, donations, grants, and contributions from any public  
11 or private source and designated for the purpose set forth in this  
12 section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
13 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma  
14 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry for the purpose of  
15 administering the International Livestock Judging Competition Grant  
16 Act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued  
17 by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law  
18 with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
19 Services for approval and payment.

20 B. The International Livestock Judging Competition Revolving  
21 Fund shall never exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)  
22 at any given time.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-3 of Title 2, unless there is  
3 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. The Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall  
5 administer the provisions of the International Livestock Judging  
6 Competition Grant Act.

7 B. The State Board of Agriculture shall promulgate rules and  
8 adopt eligibility guidelines necessary to enforce and administer the  
9 International Livestock Judging Competition Grant Act, including an  
10 application process for grants. Teams that receive grants must be  
11 comprised of Oklahoma students who are members of a National FFA  
12 Organization chapter or 4-H team that has won a national competition  
13 and is eligible to compete in an international livestock judging  
14 competition.

15 C. Grants shall be awarded to match the funds the teams have  
16 raised in a one-to-one ratio (1:1), the total amount not to exceed  
17 the estimated cost of the trip for an international livestock  
18 judging competition.

19 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
