10 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to Tribal-State agreements; enacting  
12 law to offer supplemental compact terms to affirm and  
13 extend existing agreements pertaining to motor  
14 vehicle registration and licensing.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1221.B of Title 74, unless there  
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The Legislature finds that:

20 1. Oklahoma has benefited from its implementation of the policy  
21 set forth in Section 1221 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
22 through, among other things, the formation and entry of  
23 intergovernmental agreements or compacts with Tribal nations on a  
24 variety of subjects;

1           2. As an exercise of executive authority consistent with this  
2 codified policy, the Oklahoma Governor formed and entered certain  
3 Tribal-State agreements relating to motor vehicle licensing and  
4 registration matters, which agreements have benefited all parties by  
5 reducing intergovernmental disputes and increasing revenues  
6 available for roads, bridges, schools, and other valuable community  
7 infrastructure.

8           B. The State of Oklahoma now offers the following supplemental  
9 term to any Tribe that was, as of January 1, 2023, a party to a  
10 motor vehicle licensing or registration agreement previously  
11 executed by an Oklahoma Governor:

12                                   AFFIRMATION AND EXTENSION OF  
13                   MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSING/REGISTRATION COMPACT  
14                                   Between the [NAME OF TRIBE]  
15                                   and the STATE OF OKLAHOMA

16           The motor vehicle licensing or registration and license  
17 tag agreement formed and entered by the Oklahoma Governor and  
18 the [NAME OF TRIBE] is hereby affirmed as a compact between the  
19 STATE OF OKLAHOMA and [NAME OF TRIBE] and shall be in effect  
20 until January 1, 2028. The State of Oklahoma shall not  
21 withdraw from such compact prior to such date, provided nothing  
22 herein precludes the Tribe from withdrawing at an earlier date  
23 in accord with any mechanism prescribed by the compact.

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1 C. Tribal acceptance of this offer shall be indicated by letter  
2 from the Tribal party's governing body or official reciting the  
3 terms set forth above and delivered to the Oklahoma Tax Commission.  
4 Such acceptance letter, including the terms set forth above and  
5 delivered to the Oklahoma Tax Commission, shall then be filed with  
6 the Oklahoma Secretary of State.

7 D. Within six (6) months of January 1, 2028, the Oklahoma  
8 Governor is authorized to offer an additional five (5) year  
9 extension of compact term, which offer may be accepted in the same  
10 manner as provided in subsection C of this section.
