PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to medical marijuana; directing licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana commercial growers to sell certain medical marijuana products in pre-packaged form; providing requirements for packaging; allowing for the display and smelling of marijuana; directing the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 431.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana flower, trim, shake, kief, medical marijuana product, or other flower-based product not defined as a concentrate, shall be sold by licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana commercial growers to licensed medical marijuana dispensaries only

1 in pre-packaged form in package sizes weighing not less than one-
2 half (1/2) of one (1) gram to not more than three (3) ounces.

3 B. Nonopaque materials may be used when packaging medical
4 marijuana flower provided all other packaging and labeling
5 requirements for medical marijuana products sold in this state are
6 met and it is placed in an opaque container before leaving a
7 licensed medical marijuana dispensary.

8 C. The display and smelling of medical marijuana shall be
9 allowed pursuant to Section 421 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma
10 Statutes.

11 D. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority shall promulgate
12 rules necessary to allow for pre-packaged products to be returned to
13 the licensed medical marijuana dispensary when found defective or
14 hazardous to the health of the patient. The Authority shall further
15 promulgate rules necessary to allow for the return of medical
16 marijuana products from a licensed medical marijuana dispensary to a
17 licensed medical marijuana processor or licensed medical marijuana
18 commercial grower, from a licensed medical marijuana processor to a
19 licensed medical marijuana commercial grower, or from any other
20 licensed entity that transferred medical marijuana products to
21 another licensed entity.
