11 An Act relating to state government; requiring  
12 certain office holders to provide notification to  
13 successor when absent from the state; providing for  
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8.20 of Title 74, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Prior to being absent from the state, every office holder listed  
21 in the line of succession provided in Section 15 of Article VI of  
22 the Oklahoma Constitution shall provide electronic notification to  
23 his or her successor indicating the start date and time of the  
24 absence and the anticipated return date and time.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
