10 An Act relating to libraries; amendatory 65 O.S.
11 2021, Section 155, which relates to city-county
12 library commissions; modifying meeting dates;
13 providing an effective date; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 65 O.S. 2021, Section 155, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 155. The commission shall elect its chairman from the
19 appointed members and fill such other offices as its bylaws may
20 establish. The term of the chairman shall be one (1) year. The
21 commission shall hold at least one meeting each ~~month~~ year and at
22 other times as deemed necessary by the Commission, and all meetings
23 shall be open to the public. It shall adopt rules for the
24 transaction of business and keep a record of its functions and

1 activities, which record shall be a public record. Six
2 commissioners shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of
3 conducting business and exercising the powers of the commission.
4 The commission may establish a schedule of fees to cover various
5 services rendered and may also contract with other persons and
6 agencies for such services as it may require, including private
7 legal counsel and private auditing service, within the limits of its
8 appropriations, and may incur necessary expenses. The commission
9 may contract for, receive, and utilize any grants or other financial
10 assistance from the United States or from any other source, public
11 or private, in furtherance of its functions; may incur necessary
12 expenses in obtaining said grants and/or financial assistance,
13 within the limits of its appropriations; and shall receive and
14 disburse such grants and/or other financial assistance in such
15 manner as herein provided.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
