10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to appropriations; making an  
12 appropriation to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority;  
13 stating purpose; providing lapse dates; requiring and  
14 prohibiting certain budget procedures; and declaring  
15 an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health  
18 Care Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, from any  
19 monies not otherwise appropriated from the Oklahoma Health Care  
20 Authority CMIA Programs Disbursing Fund (340), the sum of Six  
21 Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may  
22 be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Health  
23 Care Authority by law.

1 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24), or may be  
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25).  
5 Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
6 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds  
7 remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall  
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June  
10 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse  
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24 and not required to pay  
14 obligations for that fiscal year may be budgeted for FY-25, after  
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
17 from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been  
18 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
