A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-34 of Title 2, unless there is 15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 17 for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be 18 designated the "Oklahoma City National Memorial Education Revolving 19 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal 20 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the 21 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from 22 legislative appropriations for the purpose of providing curriculum 23 materials and instruction on the April 19, 1995, Alfred P. accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may

be expended by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and

Forestry for the purpose provided for in this section.

Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma City National Memorial Education Revolving Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) or so much thereof as necessary for the purpose of providing curriculum materials and instruction on the April 19, 1995, Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building bombing to Oklahoma students.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
