Higher education; creating The Sergeant CJ Nelson Legacy Act; providing fee waiver for Title: children of certain individuals; effective date.

Together with Engrossed Senate Amendments thereto, beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendations:

- 1. That the Senate recede from Amendment No. 1: and
- 2. That the House concurs in Senate Amendment No. 2 and Senate Amendment No. 3; and
- 3. By adopting the following conference committee amendment to restore the title to read as follows:

An Act relating to higher education; creating the Sergeant CJ Nelson Legacy Act; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 3218.7-1, which relates to waiver of room and board fees for children of commissioned members of Oklahoma Law Enforcement; directing for the waiver of room and board fees for surviving children of first responders who have given their lives in the line of duty; setting time period; defining terms; directing for waiver of career technology district fees for surviving children of first responder who have given their lives in the line of duty; setting time period; defining terms; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as "The Sergeant CJ

20	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 3218.7-1, is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	Section 3218.7-1 A. Within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
23	Education, no fees nor room and board shall be charged to the

4	2. Children of Oklahoma firefighters who have given their lives

7	Enforcement Retirement System, who have given their lives in the
8	line of duty; and
9	4. Children of Oklahoma emergency medical technicians who have
10	given their lives in the line of duty.
11	B. Such waiver of room and board shall be limited to a period
12	of five (5) years.
13	C. Such waiver of room and board shall be a service benefit of
14	a commissioned member of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement
15	System.
16	D. For purposes of this section:
17	1. "Firefighter" means a volunteer firefighter or a permanent
18	salaried professional member of any fire department within the State
19	of Oklahoma; and
20	2. "Emergency medical technician" means a person volunteering
21	or employed as an emergency medical technician and who is licensed
22	as an emergency medical technician pursuant to Section 1-2505 of
