7	SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION
8	An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-149.8, which relates to employee injury on
9	the job; requiring paid leave of absence for employee who is a victim of a battery or an assault and
10	battery while working; prescribing minimum amount of days for paid leave; mandating paid leave until
11	medical clearance if injury occurs; and providing an effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-149.8, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 6-149.8 An education employee who is injured as a
19	result the victim of an assault or a battery or an assault and
20	battery upon the person of the employee while the employee is in the
21	performance of any duties as an education employee shall be entitled
22	to a <u>paid</u> leave of absence from employment with the school without a
23	loss of leave benefits for a minimum of seven (7) days. If the
24	employee is injured as a result of the battery or assault and

1	battery, the paid leave of absence without a loss of leave benefits
2	shall continue until the employee is medically cleared to return to
3	employment.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
