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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.20 of Title 56, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall seek waivers, and  
18 other federal approvals, that modify the state plan to allow  
19 Medicaid coverage of women for twelve (12) months after the end of a  
20 pregnancy.

21 B. If either a woman for the duration of her pregnancy and for  
22 the postpartum period consisting of the twelve-month period  
23 beginning on the last day of her pregnancy, or a child under one (1)  
24 year of age, is living in a family that has an income that is at or

1 below two hundred five percent (205%) of the most current federal  
2 poverty level, such individual is automatically qualified for  
3 Medicaid eligibility.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
