C. In order for services provided by clinical psychology
interns completing required internships, postdoctoral fellows
completing required supervision for licensure to be reimbursed, the
following conditions must be met:

7 1. The licensed practitioner must have a supervision agreement
8 letter from the Oklahoma State Board of Examiners of Psychologist on
9 file covering the dates of services of the internship or
10 postdoctoral fellowship;

11 2. The psychology intern or postdoctoral fellow must be under 12 the direct supervision of the licensed psychologist responsible for 13 the member's care;

a. staff the member's case with the intern or fellow,

c. be available to the intern or postdoctoral fellow for
