8 An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring permit
9 for the movement of certain farm equipment on certain
10 roads and highways; requiring certain farm equipment
11 comply with existing law; requiring the Department of
12 Transportation issue certain special permit; setting
13 fee for special permit; providing for codification;
14 and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-127 of Title 47, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Provided an operator has obtained an annual permit from the
20 Oklahoma Department of Transportation as provided by subsection B of
21 this section, farm equipment including, but not limited to, farm
22 tractors and other implements of husbandry, as defined in Sections
23 1-118 and 1-125 of this title, that are used solely for commercial
24 non-agricultural purposes, may be operated on any road or highway of

1 this state, except those highways which are part of the National
2 System of Interstate and Defense Highways. Operation of such farm
3 equipment shall be subject to all existing height and weight
4 restrictions and equipment requirements provided by law.

5 B. The Department of Transportation shall, upon proper
6 application, issue a special annual permit to any person allowing
7 the movement of vehicles, described in subsection A of this section.
8 The fee for the annual permit shall be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
9 per year, per vehicle.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
