7 An Act relating to poor persons; requiring Department
8 of Human Services to report certain information;
9 providing for codification; providing an effective
10 date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1020.1 of Title 56, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Beginning July 1, 2023, the Department of Human Services shall
16 report the following information quarterly to the Oklahoma
17 Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency (LOFT) and within thirty
18 (30) days after a request has been made in writing by LOFT:

19 1. Any payments made to providers in the prior fiscal year for
20 home- and community-based services for individuals with intellectual
21 disabilities; and

22 2. A strategic plan for serving more individuals with
23 intellectual disabilities through home- and community-based services
24 including goals and progress toward achieving such goals.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
