10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
12 General; transferring remaining balances of prior
13 appropriations to certain revolving funds; specifying
14 amounts; identifying sources and destinations of
15 transfers; providing purposes; providing for
16 noncodification; providing an effective date; and
17 declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 TRANSFER: Of the funds originally appropriated to the Office of
22 the Attorney General pursuant to Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill
23 No. 2958 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
24 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
transfer the sum of Four Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

1 (\$4,550,000.00) to the Victims of Human Trafficking and Prevention
2 Revolving Fund created in Section 748.3 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes to be budgeted and expended in accordance with law.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
5 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

6 TRANSFER: Of the funds originally appropriated to the Office of
7 the Attorney General pursuant to Section 124 of Enrolled Senate Bill
8 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
9 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
10 transfer the sum of Seven Million Eight Hundred Ninety-six Thousand
11 Five Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$7,896,567.00) to the Federal
12 Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund created by
13 Enrolled House Bill No. 4066 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma
14 Legislature to be budgeted and expended in accordance with law.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

16 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
