fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

- B. Any digitization shall include a disclosure that the image is a digitization. Failure to disclose shall result in a misdemeanor.
 - C. For purposes of this act:
 - 1. The term "digitization" shall mean a still or video image that is altered to appear in a realistic manner utilizing an image or images of a person other than the person depicted or computer-generated images;
 - 2. The term "disseminate" means to give, provide, lend, deliver, mail, send, forward, transfer, or transmit, electronically or otherwise, to another person; and
 - 3. The term "publish" means:
 - a. to disseminate with the intent that such images be sold by another person, or
 - b. to post, present, display, exhibit, circulate, advertise, or allow access to, electronically or otherwise, so as to make an image or images available to the public.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
- 20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
