L5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L6	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L7	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-114.16 of Title 70, unless
L8	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L9	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Teacher
20	Compensation Review and Adjustment Act".
21	B. The State Board of Education shall, in each odd-numbered
22	year, conduct a comprehensive review of the average annual salary of
23	teachers in the surrounding states of Arkansas, Colorado, Kansas,

As used in the Teacher Compensation Review and Adjustment 2 Act: "Average annual salary": 3 1. 4 means the arithmetic mean of the average annual salary 5 groups defined in paragraph 2 of this subsection and is the average gross salary regularly paid or 6 7 stipulated to be paid to an individual before deductions for taxes, retirement, health insurance, 8 9 and other similar expenses, shall include regular salaries for full-time and part-10 b. 11 time employees considered to be in permanent 12 employment positions, and 1.3 C. shall not include: 14 (1)extra duty pay, 15 payments for teaching summer school, unless the (2)16 employee has a twelve-month contract, or 17 (3) employee benefits, unless the benefits are 18 provided pursuant to 26 U.S.C., Section 125 19 related to Cafeteria Plans or health flexible 20 spending arrangements that reduce the employee's 2.1 salary for tax purposes; 22 "Average annual salary groups" includes: 23 "all instructional staff salary" which means the a. 24 average annual salary of full-time equivalent

instructional staff and shall be the weighted arithmetic mean of the combined annual salaries of classroom teachers, substitute teachers, principals, supervisors, and other instructional personnel,

- b. "elementary classroom teacher salary" which means the average annual salary of the full-time equivalent elementary classroom teachers,
- c. "secondary classroom teacher salary" which means the average annual salary of the full-time equivalent secondary classroom teachers, and
- d. "average classroom teacher salary" which means the weighted arithmetic mean of salary figures calculated in subparagraphs b and c of this paragraph; and
- 3. "Teachers" means all of the categories of certified personnel who are eligible for salary compensation based on years of experience and step levels described in Section 18-114.15 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- D. If the average annual salary of teachers in the surrounding states is determined to be greater than the average annual salary of teachers in this state, the Legislature shall introduce a bill to provide a salary increase for teachers up to but not to exceed the average annual salary in the surrounding states, to ensure competitiveness with surrounding states.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 59-2-10481 EK 02/26/24
