7	SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION
8	An Act relating to teachers; creating the Return to Teach Signing Bonus Act; establishing a signing bonus
9	program for certain teachers; subjecting program to availability of funds; listing requirements for
10	program participants; prescribing installment payments for bonus; setting maximum amount of bonus
11	per teacher; describing process for bonus payments; directing State Department of Education to verify
12	applicant information; excluding bonus from being included in certain calculations; providing for
13	promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-401 of Title 70, unless there
20	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Return to
22	Teach Signing Bonus Act".
23	B. Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year and subject to the
24	availability of funding, the State Department of Education shall

1 establish and administer a signing bonus program for teachers who
2 return to teaching in Oklahoma public schools.

3 C. To participate in the signing bonus program, the applicant 4 shall:

5 1. Be a teacher with at least three (3) years of prior teaching
6 experience and a valid or expired teaching certificate issued by:

- 7 a. the State Board of Education,
- 8 b. the education certification entity of another state,
- 9 c. the National Board for Professional Teaching
 10 Standards, or

d. the education certification entity of another country;
2. Have not been employed by an Oklahoma public school district
within the past five (5) years at the time of applying;

14 3. Agree to be a full-time public school teacher in the state 15 for a minimum of five (5) years;

4. Submit proof of his or her most recent teaching employment
which may include a paystub or letter from the school district
superintendent or board of education;

19 5. Submit proof provided by the school district where the 20 applicant will be employed as a full-time teacher; and

6. Any additional requirements established by the State Boardof Education.

D. The signing bonus shall be paid in five (5) equal annual
installments of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00) per year for a

1 period of five (5) years. The total amount of the signing bonus shall not exceed Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) per 2 participant. Upon verification required by subsection E of this 3 section, each installment of the signing bonus shall be paid to 4 5 participants no later than September 1 of each year or within thirty 6 (30) days of the first day of school, whichever is earlier. If an 7 applicant is approved to participate in the signing bonus program after the school year has started, the signing bonus shall be 8 9 prorated for the first year based on the percentage of days the 10 participating teacher is contracted to work.

E. 1. Prior to payment of any signing bonuses, the Department shall verify all of the information submitted by the applicant pursuant to subsection C of this section is accurate and confirm the applicant is eligible to participate in the signing bonus program.

15 2. Prior to the beginning of each school year after the 16 teacher's first year participating in the signing bonus program, the 17 teacher shall provide verification to the Department that the 18 teacher continues to be eligible for the signing bonus program, 19 including documentation from the Oklahoma school district where the 20 teacher is employed full time.

F. Any signing bonus paid pursuant to the Return to Teach Signing Bonus Act shall not be included in the calculation of salary for purposes of meeting the district or statutory minimum salary

1	schedule or for purposes of calculating Teachers' Retirement System
2	of Oklahoma contributions or benefits.
3	G. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to implement
4	the provisions of the Return to Teach Signing Bonus Act.
5	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
