CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Commissioners of the Land Office; amending 64 O.S. 2021, Section 1005, which relates to appointment of the Secretary of the Land Office; requiring appointment to be subject to the advice and consent of the Senate; providing for termination of the Secretary upon passage of certain resolution; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 64 O.S. 2021, Section 1005, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1005. A. The Land Office shall be administered by the Secretary of the Land Office under the supervision of the Commissioners of the Land Office. The Secretary shall, subject to the qualifications listed in subsection B of this section, be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Commissioners of the Land Office and the advice and consent of the

1 provided for in this section. The Secretary shall be terminated
2 upon the passage of a concurrent resolution, if the resolution
3 receives the approval of two-thirds (2/3) of the membership of the
4 House of Representatives and two-thirds (2/3) of the membership of
5 the Senate.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
