7 An Act relating to appropriations; making an
8 appropriation to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority;
9 stating purpose; providing lapse dates; requiring and
10 prohibiting certain budget procedures; and declaring
11 an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health
14 Care Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, from any
15 monies not otherwise appropriated from the Oklahoma Health Care
16 Authority CMIA Programs Disbursing Fund (340), the sum of Six
17 Hundred Million Dollars (\$600,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Health
19 Care Authority by law.

20 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including
21 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24), or may be
23 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25).
24 Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30,

1 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds
2 remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall
3 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
4 year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June
5 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse
6 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
7 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
8 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24 and not required to pay
9 obligations for that fiscal year may be budgeted for FY-25, after
10 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
11 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
12 from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been
13 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
