7 An Act relating to childbirth; creating the Choosing  
8 Childbirth Revolving Fund; specifying type of fund  
9 and source of monies; providing for expenditure of  
funds; providing for codification; providing an  
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-740.20 of Title 63, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
17 for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Choosing  
18 Childbirth Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund,  
19 not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all  
20 monies received by the Department from appropriations provided for  
21 the purpose of funding services under the Choosing Childbirth Act.  
22 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
23 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for  
24 the purpose provided for in this section. Expenditures from the

1 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
2 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the  
3 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and  
4 payment.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
