13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new sec	tion of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.19b of Title 74, unless	
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:	
16	There is hereby created in the State	e Treasury a revolving fund
17	for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to be designated the	
18	"Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation Centennial Revolving Fund".	
19	The fund shall be a continuing fund, not	subject to fiscal year
20	limitations, and shall consist of all mo	onies received by the
21	Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation from gifts, donations, or any	
22	other source. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are	
23	hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma	
24	State Bureau of Investigation for the pu	rpose of celebrating the

1	centennial of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.	
2	Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the	
3	State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the	
4	Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for	
5	approval and payment.	
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.	
7	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation	
8	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby	
9	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and	
10	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
