7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society;
8 requiring that certain appropriated funds be used for
9 certain purposes; directing certain transfer;
10 providing for lapse of funds under certain
11 conditions; and requiring and prohibiting certain
12 budget procedures.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
15 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
16 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the Oklahoma
17 Historical Society is hereby authorized to expend Two Hundred Four
18 Thousand Dollars (\$204,000.00) for increased aid to affiliate sites
19 across the state. These funds shall be in addition to previous
20 years' budgeted funds, and shall not be used to supplant such funds.

21 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
22 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
23 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the Oklahoma
24 Historical Society is hereby authorized to expend Five Million

1 Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) for operations to the Native American
2 Cultural and Educational Authority for fiscal years 2024 and 2025.

3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
4 Historical Society in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
5 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the Oklahoma
6 Historical Society shall transfer Eighteen Million Dollars
7 (\$18,000,000.00) to the Oklahoma Museum of Popular Culture
8 Supplemental Revolving Fund, created in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 22
9 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature.

10 SECTION 4. Appropriations made to the Oklahoma Historical
11 Society by Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary
12 Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
13 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24), or may be
15 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25).
16 Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30,
17 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds
18 remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall
19 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
20 year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June
21 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse
22 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
23 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
24 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not required to pay

1 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-25, after
2 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
3 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
4 from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been
5 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
