7	An Act relating to the Department of Human Services; requiring that certain funds be utilized for certain
8	purpose; requiring certain funding be used as additional or supplemental funding; requiring certain
9	funding be maintained at certain levels; requiring certain joint approval prior to certain actions;
10 11	requiring certain transfers to certain funds; appropriating certain federal funds for certain program; authorizing early allocation of funds under
12	certain conditions; authorizing certain transfers; requiring the maintenance of certain records;
13	providing budgeting and expenditure limitations and procedures; providing for lapse of funds under
14	certain conditions; and requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures.
15	
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
18	Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
19	Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
20	Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall be used for providing
21	Home and Community-Based Waiver services for persons with
22	developmental disabilities. These funds shall be used to provide
23	additional services and programs for persons with developmental
24	disabilities in order to eliminate the Developmental Disabilities

Services Division Waitlist. Such funds shall be used to supplement
rather than replace existing resources and programs.

3 SECTION 2. From available funds for the fiscal year ending June 4 30, 2024, the Department shall make permanent the supplemental daily 5 reimbursement rate of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for childcare providers 6 which was in effect in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 7 Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st 8 9 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department shall maintain the funding levels for senior nutrition 10 programs from the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. The Oklahoma 11 12 Legislature requires joint approval from the President Pro Tempore 13 of the Oklahoma State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives before any senior nutrition sites may be closed 14 due to declining attendance or increased operational costs during 15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024. 16

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 17 Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st 18 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the 19 Department of Human Services shall transfer Five Million Six Hundred 20 Thousand Dollars (\$5,600,000.00) to the credit of the Child Abuse 21 Multidisciplinary Account established in Section 1-9-103 of Title 22 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes, which shall be distributed according 23 to Section 1-9-104 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes. 24

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SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services all federal monies received by the state during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant and the Child Care and Development Fund Block Grant to meet the provisions of federal law relating to such grants.

SECTION 6. The Director of the Department of Human Services may request through the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

13 SECTION 7. A. The Director of the Office of Management and 14 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies appropriated from the 15 General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services' disbursing 16 funds in the amounts and ratios requested by the agency except that 17 the cumulative amount transferred shall not exceed the cumulative 18 amount of equal monthly allotments of the appropriations from the 19 General Revenue Fund.

B. Monies appropriated or collected for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, may be transferred to these disbursing funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to satisfy encumbrances and obligations of the fiscal year, provided that monies equal in amount are transferred from appropriations or collections for the fiscal

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year ending June 30, 2023, to the disbursing funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, to satisfy encumbrances and obligations of the fiscal year. All transfer requests shall be in writing to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. C. The Department of Human Services shall maintain records of such inter-year transfers.

7 SECTION 8. The Director of Human Services may request the 8 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to 9 transfer monies between the Department of Human Services Support 10 Service Providers Grant Program Fund and the Human Services 11 Disbursing Fund or the Human Services Medical and Assistance Fund, 12 as needed for the expenditure of funds.

SECTION 9. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 13 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, 14 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may 15 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-16 24), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 17 (hereafter FY-25). Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only 18 through June 30, 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. 19 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for 20 FY-25, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then 21 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered 22 only through June 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 23 2025, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then 24

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1	current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in
2	both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not
3	required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
4	for FY-25, after the agency to which the funds have been
5	appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
6	revision removing these funds from the FY-24 budget work program and
7	after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management
8	and Enterprise Services.
