8 9	establishing amounts; providing purposes; requiring and limiting the utilization of funds; creating certain special accounts; limiting duration of
9	accounts; requiring certain determinations; providing and limiting the nature of accounts and the funds
10	within the accounts; authorizing agency to submit request for certain deposits or transfers; requiring
11	certain compliance and verifications; authorizing certain memorandums of understanding; limiting scope;
13	prohibiting certain memoranda terms; authorizing and limiting the promulgation of rules and utilization of
14	procedures; authorizing and limiting the retention of monies for administration costs; requiring certain
15	reports and submissions to certain entities; requiring appearance before certain joint committee;
16	limiting duration of certain requirements; providing determination process; establishing requirements; and
17	declaring an emergency.
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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
21	Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
22	Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled
23	House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma
24	Legislature, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so

much thereof as may be necessary to prepare more young adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities or autism to live and work independently. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 19, 2023.

There is hereby appropriated to the Department of 6 SECTION 2. Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the 7 Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled 8 9 House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Ten Million Three Hundred Nine Thousand Nine 10 Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$10,309,911.00) or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary to enhance and increase capacity for programs assisting in 13 stabilizing justice involved women, their children, and caregivers in the Tulsa area and into surrounding rural areas of Oklahoma. 14 Such funds shall be utilized in a manner consistent with the 15 recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief 16 Funding on May 19, 2023. 17

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$3,814,950.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to support and expand proven-effective

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programming for justice involved women in the Oklahoma City area and
 into rural areas of Oklahoma. Such funds shall be utilized in a
 manner consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint
 Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 19, 2023.

5 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the 6 Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled 7 House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma 8 9 Legislature, the sum of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to allow more 10 opportunities for working families with children, with and without 11 12 special needs, to obtain high-quality childcare. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner consistent with the recommendations adopted 13 by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 19, 2023. 14 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 15 SECTION 5. A. Statewide Recovery Special Account for each appropriation section in 16 this act. The duration of such accounts shall continue for the 17 period of time that monies related to the American Rescue Plan Act 18 of 2021 are being budgeted, expended, or managed in the state. 19 The ending of such period shall be determined by the State Treasurer, 20 and shall result in the closing of such accounts as a matter of law. 21 Such accounts shall be continuing accounts as otherwise provided in 22 this section, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 23 exclusively consist of monies related to the relevant appropriations 24

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1 made in this act and as otherwise directed by law. All monies 2 deposited to the credit of such accounts are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department of Human Services in 3 accordance with the provisions of this act. Expenditures from such 4 5 accounts shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the 6 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and 7 8 payment.

9 Β. The Department of Human Services is authorized to request in 10 writing that the monies appropriated by the provisions of this act be deposited or transferred to the accounts created pursuant to 11 12 subsection A of this section. No later than seven (7) calendar days from the date of such request, the Director of the Office of 13 Management and Enterprise Services shall comply with such request 14 and verify to the requesting agency that such deposit or transfer 15 has been completed. 16

SECTION 6. The Department of Human Services may enter into 17 memorandums of understanding with other agencies of the State of 18 Oklahoma for the auditing, documentation, evaluation, 19 implementation, oversight, reporting, and management of funds and 20 associated efforts related to the appropriations made in this act; 21 provided, no such memorandum of understanding shall require or 22 include, as an option or condition, the direct or practical transfer 23 or relinquishment of control by the agency appropriated such funds 24

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1 to budget, expend, allocate, and request the distribution of the 2 funds appropriated by this act.

3 SECTION 7. The Department of Human Services may promulgate 4 rules, utilize existing rules, establish procedures, and utilize 5 existing procedures to implement the provisions of this act, 6 provided such rules and procedures do not conflict with or impede 7 the provisions of this act.

8 SECTION 8. The Department of Human Services shall retain no 9 more than two percent (2%) of the funds appropriated by this act to 10 reimburse:

11 1. Costs incurred by the Department of Human Services; or

12 2. Costs incurred on the agency's behalf,

13 associated with the administration of the appropriated funds and 14 programming required by the Department of Human Services under the 15 provisions of this act; provided, no funds shall be retained that 16 would be disallowable under the provisions of the American Rescue 17 Plan Act of 2021.

18 SECTION 9. A. The Department of Human Services shall:

Submit to the chairs of the Joint Committee on Pandemic
 Relief Funding, or any successor of the Oklahoma State Senate or
 Oklahoma House of Representatives legislative committee or joint
 committee, as designated by the President Pro Tempore of the
 Oklahoma State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
 Representatives:

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- a. a written or electronic quarterly report detailing the
 budgeting, expenditure, and management of all monies
 appropriated in this act, and
- b. a copy of all memorandums of understanding and
 contracts with third parties entered into by the
 Department of Human Services to facilitate, assist, or
 administer powers and duties provided to the
 Department of Human Services under the provisions of
 this act; and

10 2. At the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding's request, 11 appear before the Joint Committee no later than six (6) months after 12 the effective date of this act, and as otherwise requested by the 13 Joint Committee to provide a status update regarding the 14 implementation of the provisions of this act.

The provisions of subsection A of this section shall remain 15 Β. applicable for the period of time that monies appropriated under 16 17 this act are being budgeted, expended, or managed in the state. The ending of such period shall be determined by the State Treasurer, 18 and shall be reported to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the 19 20 Oklahoma State Senate, and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives. 21

SECTION 10. For all projects funded in this measure, if a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization may help implement the project, the

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1 Department of Human Services shall require the nonprofit show that
2 it:

3 1. Provides direct services to residents of Oklahoma; 2. Is in good standing with the Office of the Secretary of 4 5 State; 6 3. Is in compliance with the applicable federal and Oklahoma tax laws for years 2019, 2020, and 2021; and 7 4. Continues to provide its good standing with the Office of 8 9 the Secretary of State and is in compliance with applicable federal

10 and Oklahoma tax laws for all years the nonprofit is helping 11 implement the program.

12 SECTION 11. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
