Supp. 2022, Section 7 6-124), which relates to issuance of license or identification card to veterans; requiring certain 8 disabled veterans' disability rating be notated on 9 driver licenses or identification cards; allowing for spouses and unremarried surviving spouses of certain veterans to receive disability rating or veteran 10 status notation on driver licenses or identification cards; requiring notation be accepted as proof of 11 sales tax exemption and veterans benefits; requiring certain registration to receive notations; requiring 12 implementation of certain information exchange process by certain date; requiring compliance with 13 certain standards for certain licenses; directing Service Oklahoma to seek certain federal approval; 14 and providing an effective date. 15 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-124, as 18 amended by Section 63, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, 19 Section 6-124), is amended to read as follows: 20 Section 6-124. A. As a way to honor and recognize the veterans 21 who have served our country, Service Oklahoma shall make space 22 available in the upper left-hand corner of the front of the driver 23

license and the identification card for a flag emblem and the word

1 "veteran" to. Similarly, when applicable, Service Oklahoma shall, 2 either on the front or back of the driver license or the identification card, include a numeric designation indicating a 3 4 veteran's one-hundred-percent disability rating granted to the 5 veteran by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. The items required by this subsection shall be designed by Service 6 Oklahoma that will serve as a notation of veteran status as well as 7 a notation of the existence of a United States Department of 8 9 Veterans Affairs disability rating as applicable. The current 10 spouse of a one-hundred-percent disabled veteran or an unremarried surviving spouse of a deceased, one-hundred-percent disabled veteran 11 12 shall be entitled to receive a driver license or identification card indicating his or her status as an eligible current spouse or an 13 eligible unremarried surviving spouse entitled to the sales tax 14 exemption provided in Section 1357 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma 15 Statutes. Representation of veteran status and disability rating on 16 the driver license and the identification card shall be adequate 17 confirmation for purposes of veterans benefits offered by public or 18 private entities doing business within this state and no further 19 documentation shall be required except as specifically mandated by 20 federal law. 21

B. Upon application for issuance or renewal of the driver license or identification card and in addition to other documentation required by Service Oklahoma, persons requesting the

- D. With regard to the issuance of REAL-ID compliant licenses

- 22 | seek design approval from all necessary federal agencies, including
- 23 | but not limited to the United States Department of Homeland
- 24 | Security.

1	E. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate any rule necessary to
2	implement the provisions of this section.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
