18 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 1 of
Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution; clarifying
19 certain voting requirement; providing ballot title;
and directing filing.

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
23 2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

1 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
2 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
3 the following proposed amendment to Section 1 of Article III of the
4 Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

5 Section 1. Qualifications of electors.

6 Subject to such exceptions as the Legislature may prescribe, ~~all~~
7 only citizens of the United States, who are over the age of eighteen
8 (18) years, and who are bona fide residents of this state, are
9 qualified electors of this state.

10 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
11 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
12 the following form:

14 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

15 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

16 This measure amends Section 1 of Article 3 of the Oklahoma
17 Constitution. It clarifies that only citizens of the United
18 States are qualified to vote in this state.

22 SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
23 immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file
24 one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2

1 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney
2 General.
