7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 59 O.S. 2021,
8 Section 582, which relates to the Board of Examiners
9 in Optometry; and removing Board from Oklahoma Sunset
10 Law.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 582, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 582. There is hereby re-created, ~~to continue until July~~
15 ~~1, 2023, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset~~
16 ~~Law,~~ the Board of Examiners in Optometry. This Board shall consist
17 of five (5) persons, four of whom shall possess sufficient knowledge
18 of theoretical and practical optics to practice optometry, be duly
19 licensed as optometrists, and who shall have been residents of this
20 state actually engaged in the practice of optometry for at least
21 five (5) years. The term of each licensed optometrist member of the
22 Board, one being appointed each year, shall be five (5) years, or
23 until a qualified successor is appointed. The lay member of the
24 Board shall serve a term coterminous with that of the Governor and
