7 An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
8 General; transferring remaining balances of prior
9 appropriations to certain revolving funds; specifying
10 amounts; identifying sources and destinations of
11 transfers; providing purposes; providing for
12 noncodification; providing an effective date; and
13 declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 TRANSFER: Of the funds originally appropriated to the Office of
18 the Attorney General pursuant to Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill
19 No. 2958 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
20 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
21 transfer the sum of Four Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
22 (\$4,550,000.00) to the Victims of Human Trafficking and Prevention
23 Revolving Fund created in Section 748.3 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
24 Statutes to be budgeted and expended in accordance with law.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
2 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3 TRANSFER: Of the funds originally appropriated to the Office of
4 the Attorney General pursuant to Section 124 of Enrolled Senate Bill
5 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
6 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
7 transfer the sum of Seven Million Eight Hundred Ninety-six Thousand
8 Five Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$7,896,567.00) to the Federal
9 Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund created by
10 Enrolled House Bill No. 4066 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma
11 Legislature to be budgeted and expended in accordance with law.

12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

13 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
