A person who disseminates or publishes a digitization 18 depicting another person's name, image, voice, or likeness without 19 their written consent and attempts to deceive with the intent to 20 cause emotional, financial, or physical harm shall be quilty of a 21 misdemeanor on a first offense. A second offense shall result in a

felony punishable by no less than one (1) year imprisonment and a

fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

- B. Any digitization shall include a disclosure that the image is a digitization. Failure to disclose shall result in a misdemeanor.
 - C. For purposes of this act:
 - 1. The term "digitization" shall mean a still or video image that is altered to appear in a realistic manner utilizing an image or images of a person other than the person depicted or computergenerated images;
 - 2. The term "disseminate" means to give, provide, lend, deliver, mail, send, forward, transfer, or transmit, electronically or otherwise, to another person; and
 - 3. The term "publish" means:
 - a. to disseminate with the intent that such images be sold by another person, or
 - b. to post, present, display, exhibit, circulate, advertise, or allow access to, electronically or otherwise, so as to make an image or images available to the public.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
