11 A Joint Resolution relating to a Constitutional
Convention pursuant to Article V of the United
12 States Constitution; application; distribution.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
16 AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

17 Section 1. The Oklahoma Legislature of Oklahoma hereby makes an
18 application to Congress, as provided by Article V of the
19 Constitution of the United States of America, to call a convention
20 limited to proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United
21 States of America to set a limit on the number of terms that a
22 person may be elected as a Member of the United States House of
23 Representatives and to set a limit on the number of terms that a
24 person may be elected as a Member of the United States Senate.

1 Section 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
2 transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary
3 of the Senate of the United States and to the Speaker, Clerk and
4 Judiciary Committee Chairman of the House of Representatives of the
5 Congress of the United States, and copies to the members of the said
6 Senate and House of Representatives from this State; also to
7 transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of each of the
8 legislative houses in the several States, requesting their
9 cooperation.

10 Section 3. This application shall be considered as covering the
11 same subject matter as the applications from other States to
12 Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of terms
13 that a person may be elected to the House of Representatives of the
14 Congress of the United States and the Senate of the United States;
15 and this application shall be aggregated with same for the purpose
16 of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require Congress
17 to call a limited convention on this subject, but shall not be
18 aggregated with any other applications on any other subject.

19 Section 4. This application constitutes a continuing
20 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the
21 United States of America until the legislatures of at least two-
22 thirds of the several states have made applications on the same
23 subject.
