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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-1103, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 11-1103. A. No person under the age of sixteen (16)
20	years shall drive a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
21	scooter, or motorized bicycle on any highway of this state while
22	transporting any other person.
23	B. The operator of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
24	scooter, or motorized bicycle who has attained the age of sixteen

1 (16) years or older may carry a passenger if the vehicle has a wheel 2 diameter of twelve (12) inches or greater and is factory-designed 3 and equipped with either:

A double seating device with double foot rests; or 4 1. 5 2. A sidecar attachment providing a separate seat space within such sidecar attachment for each person riding therein so that such 6 7 person shall be seated entirely within the body of said sidecar. C. No rider of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized 8 9 scooter, or motorized bicycle shall hold to any moving vehicle for 10 the purpose of being propelled.

D. No Except as otherwise provided by subsection E of this section, no driver of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized scooter, motorized bicycle, or electric-assisted bicycle shall pass other vehicles between lanes of traffic traveling in the same direction. This subsection shall not apply to the operator of an authorized emergency vehicle.

E. 1. As used in this subsection, the term "lane filtering" means the act of a two-wheeled motorcycle overtaking and passing another vehicle or vehicles that are stopped at a traffic signal or stop sign in the same lane and direction of travel as the overtaking motorcycle.

6	and E of Section 6-101 of this title. Service Oklahoma and licensed
7	operators shall distribute literature on lane filtering and lane
8	filtering safety to a current driver license holder with a
9	motorcycle endorsement when the holder applies for renewal of the
10	license.
