11 An Act relating to the World Health Organization;
12 prohibiting enforcement of policies required or
13 recommended by the World Health Organization;
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6301 of Title 74, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The World Health Organization, the United Nations and the
21 World Economic Forum shall have no jurisdiction in the State of
22 Oklahoma. The state and its political subdivisions, including, but
23 not limited to counties, cities, towns, precincts, water districts,
24 school districts, school administrative units, or quasi-public

1 entities, shall not engage in the enforcement of, or any
2 collaboration with the enforcement of, any requirements,
3 instructions, mandates, recommendations, or guidance provided by the
4 World Health Organization, the United Nations or the World Economic
5 Forum.

6 B. Any mandates, recommendations, instructions, communications
7 or guidance issued by the World Health Organization, the United
8 Nations or the World Economic Forum shall not be used in this state
9 as a basis for action, nor to direct, order or otherwise impose,
10 contrary to the constitution and laws of the State of Oklahoma any
11 requirements whatsoever, including those for masks, vaccines or
12 medical testing, or gather any public or private information about
13 the state's citizens or residents, and shall have no force or effect
14 in the State of Oklahoma.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective June 1, 2024.

16 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
