





14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 212.5 of Title 74, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Beginning no later than July 1, 2024, the State Auditor and
19 Inspector shall conduct a performance audit of expenditures on
20 homeless programs and services in this state, by:

- 21 1. The state;
- 22 2. Municipalities and counties;
- 23 3. State entities that receive federal funds allocated for
24 homeless programs and services; and

1 4. State and local law enforcement agencies.

2 B. All political subdivisions of this state shall cooperate
3 with the audit and grant access, at no cost, to all financial
4 records and other programmatic information necessary for the
5 completion of the performance audit. The audit shall examine the
6 awarding of contracts and grants relating to homeless programs and
7 services, any metric used to measure success of the expenditures,
8 whether the contractors and grantees met such metrics, and the
9 efficacy of the use of data management systems in relation to such
10 programs and services. If any service provider in this state is
11 required to provide information as part of the audit provided for in
12 this section, the submission of the most recent financial audit of
13 the service provider performed by a licensed third party shall
14 constitute compliance with the information request.

15 C. Report of such audit shall be provided electronically to the
16 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the
17 Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

18 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
