23	Section 2-8-224. A. It is unlawful for a person who is under
24	twenty-one (21) years of age to purchase, receive, or have in his or

1 her possession a tobacco product, nicotine product or vapor product, 2 or to present or offer to any person any purported proof of age which is false or fraudulent, for the purpose of purchasing or 3 receiving any tobacco product, nicotine product or vapor product. 4 5 It shall not be unlawful for an employee under twenty-one (21) years of age to handle tobacco products, nicotine products or vapor 6 products when required in the performance of the employee's duties. 7 B. When a person violates subsection A of this section, the 8 9 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission shall require 10 the violator to shall complete an education or tobacco use cessation program approved by the State Department of Health court. If the 11 12 violator fails to complete the tobacco use cessation program ordered by the court, a fine may be imposed that shall not exceed Fifty 13 Dollars (\$50.00) for a first offense or One Hundred Dollars 14 (\$100.00) for subsequent offenses. The violator may also be 15 required to complete a community service program or other 16 appropriate programs or services as ordered by the court. The court 17 shall have jurisdiction over the violator for twelve (12) months 18 following sentencing to ensure all programs and orders of the court 19 are followed. 20 С. The ABLE Commission Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement 21 (ABLE) Commission shall establish rules to provide for notification 22 to a parent or guardian of any minor cited for a violation of this 23
