



1 A. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the  
2 Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority is authorized to utilize  
3 available funds from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund created by  
4 Enrolled House Bill No. 1002 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the  
5 59th Oklahoma Legislature, in the amount of:

6 1. Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) for the benefit of  
7 the Department of Public Safety to create an Oklahoma Wireless  
8 Information Network (OKWIN);

9 2. Fifty-nine Million Five Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Four  
10 Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$59,564,419.00) for the benefit of the  
11 Department of Public Safety for the construction of a centralized  
12 training center and related facilities; and

13 3. Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00) for the benefit of the  
14 Department of Public Safety for facility upgrades, repair,  
15 expansion, and replacement of Oklahoma Highway Patrol facilities.

16 B. LCF Recapitalization Payments shall be made related to the  
17 distribution of proceeds provided in subsection A of this act, in  
18 accordance with the provisions of the Legacy Capital Financing Act.

19 C. The Authority may distribute funds authorized pursuant to  
20 subsection A in one or more tranches.

21 D. The Authority may enter memoranda of understanding with  
22 agencies, departments, and subdivisions of the state as needed, to  
23 facilitate the provisions of this act, provided that such memoranda  
24 of understanding do not constitute a legal obligation of the State

1 of Oklahoma or impede the administration of the provisions of the  
2 Legacy Capital Financing Act.
