A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427.30 of Title 63, unless there 17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 Every dispensary or any place marijuana or THC products are 19 sold shall display at all times a printed sign with a minimum height 20 of eight and a half (8 1/2) inches and a minimum width of eleven 21 (11) inches, with large visible font and posted near the cash 22 register or place of check out and at least two other highly visible 23 place in the store, which shall read as follows: 24

2	THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN UNBORN CHILD.
3	B. The signage shall be produced at the expense of the owner.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
